As the guardians of a 60acre Ancient Staffordshire Woodland, caring for 140 Barbary macaques; we are keenly aware of the impact of human influences on the environment. We aim to promote wild spaces and preserve natural/ecological habitats wherever possible. As laid out in this policy; Trentham Monkey Forest (TMF) is committed to working towards achieving a reduction in our carbon footprint and consider the most sustainable practices across our site.

Our Environmental Policy is designed to improve efficiency and aims to encourage responsible behaviour in staff, guests and visitors, business partners and the communities with whom we interact and represent. Leading by example; we hope to promote a positive behaviour change towards living sustainably.

To facilitate this policy, all permanent members of staff are involved in the planning and implementation of sustainable practices in their areas. These practices and policies will then be reviewed annually, in accordance with our winter planning.

Specifically, TMF aims to evaluate its carbon footprint, waste management and electricity usage; the main areas which have been identified as areas for improvement.
